Introduction

History of mankind is full of struggles against injustice and oppression of all kinds. It was during the course of these struggles that the conceptions of certain basic rights emerged which was later conceptualized as 'human rights'. These rights are defined as 'these minimum conditions of life which must be given to a human being by virtue of being a member of human family. It became a matter intense political discourse after the horrifying experience of 'second world war' and which ultimately led to the passing of 'Universal Declaration of Human Rights' by the U.N. General assembly on December 10, 1948. Since then a lot of effects have been made both internationally as well as nationally to protect and promote the human rights, yet violations are taking place the world over including in India in various ways .And therefore a serious effort is needed to examine as to why such violations are taking place particularly in countries having a democratic structure of governance, constitutional guarantee to fundamental rights, free press, independent judiciary, competitive party system, national human rights commission and so on. The phenomenon of globalization has further complicated the problem by throwing up many new challenges before the mankind. Growing income disparities, sharp depletion of valuable resources, displacement of people due to various development projects, environmental degradation impacting the health of common people, emergence of global terrorism and religious fundamentalism resulting in death and destruction on a massive scale etc. are some of the contemporary challenges on the human rights front.

The national seminar organized by the D.P.B.S. (P.G.) College, Anoopshahr (Bulandshahar), U.P. on 3 – 4 March, 2016 and sponsored by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh deliberated over all the contemporary issues and challenges involving human rights violations and arrived at certain conclusions and suggestions for improving the status of human rights with specific reference to India.

Within the broad theme mentioned above the focus of the seminar was on the following sub themes:

- Conceptual frameworks of human rights and its contemporary challenges
- Impact of globalization, environmental degradation, terrorism and religious fundamentalism on human rights
- Human rights violations of women, children and marginalized sections of society
- Education and human rights
- Science & technology and Human rights
- Human Rights scenario in India
- Ways and means to protect human rights in India and across the globe.

The seminar was attended by 185 persons including invited scholars and guests, external and internal delegates, research scholars, journalists and members of the college managing committee. In addition to the inaugural and valedictory sessions, five technical sessions were held during which 42 selected papers presented. Beside the invited resource persons and paper presenters, the faculty members of D.P.B.S. (P.G.) College, students, researchers and scholars actively participated in the debates and discussions during the various technical sessions.

INAUGURAL SESSION

The 'Inaugural Session' of the Seminar began in the Seminar hall of the D.P.B.S. (P.G.) College, Anoopshahr on 3rd March, 2016 at 10:30 AM with the lighting of lamp and recitation of Vedic mantras. Dr. Mukesh Gupta, principal and convener of the seminar welcomed the guests and Dr. U.K. Jha, organizing secretary introduced the theme of the seminar. It was followed by the release of souvenir and guest lectures by the learned spokespersons; Delivering keynote address, Prof. Subrata Mukharjee of Deptt. of Political Science, University of Delhi, expressed the view that in spite of its universal presence, the concept of human rights is still a contested concept as many people believe that the essence of human rights is to be found and restricted to civil and political liberties and need not be extended to the economic and social one. He also lamented at the 'unreformed' and 'unresponsive' nature of state in India and underlined the conflict between individual and

group rights. He was of the opinion that India is still following the incomplete path of liberal constitutionalism and it is among one of the most unequal nations in the world. In such a grim situation, he said, the challenges to human rights come from both state and society and would be ensured by what Habermas calls 'Vigilant constitutional citizenship'.

Prof. R.R. Jha, Dean, faculty of Social sciences and professor of Political Science at B.H.U., Varanasi was the chief guest at the inaugural session. He presented a critical analysis of the emerging dimensions of human rights and how the world community could deal with it keeping in view the particular context of India.

Prof. Madhurendra Kumar, Professor of Political science at Kumayun University, Nainital, underlined the apparent contradictions in the domain of human rights and stressed the need to investigate all those factors that hinder the enjoyment of human rights.

Prof. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma, General Secretary and Treasurer of All India Political Science Association and Professor of Political Science at C.C.S. University, Meerut explained the conceptual framework of human rights in the context of ancient Indian political traditions and stressed the need to evolve an Indian solution to the problem.

Prof. J.S. Negi, Regional Higher Education Officer, Meerut, and special guest at inaugural function high lightened the complexities of human rights violations in family and social relationships and argued for changing the mindset of the people involved in violating the rights of others. Major General G.K. Chopra, the Vice-Chancellor of Jaypee University, Anoopshahr and special guest at the inaugural session, cited the instances of human rights violations in the context of terrorism and counter-terrorism operations by the army and security personals and stressed the need to have a proper training system for army, police and security forces in the country which could sensitive them on the issue of human rights. Cdr. Amitabh Bhattacharya, Secretary of the college Managing Committee and patron of the seminar, stressed the need to evolve a suitable human rights culture in the country. Cdr. S.J. Singh, President (Education), Jaypee group and chief patron of the seminar presided over the inaugural session. He emphasized the role of education for the protection and promotion of human rights in the country.
